**on the National Social Inclusion Strategy and the government action plan on its
implementation between 2015 and 2017**

1. In line with objectives and measures to fight poverty in the National Reform Programme relating to the Europe 2020 strategy, to the end of accomplishing the objectives set out in the Hungarian National Social Inclusion Strategy II (hereinafter: NSIS II) and applying the principles of social inclusion policy laid down in the strategy, the Government hereby:

a) adopts according to Annex 1 the government action plan (hereinafter: Action Plan) for 2015 to 2017 adopted by Government Decree 1603/2014 (XI 4) on the adoption of the NSIS II, the Framework Policy of Life-Long Learning, the Public Education Development Strategy and the Mid-term Strategy against Leaving School without a Qualification, and orders its implementation with available sources taken into consideration;

b) calls upon the Minister of Human Capacities to revise the NSIS II biannually, first in 2017, in relation to the implementation of the action plan; and starting from 2016, prepare a report every year for the Government on the fulfilment of responsibilities set in the action plan on the basis of information sheets prepared in accordance with Section c),

c) calls upon the relevant ministers to take into consideration the objectives, areas of intervention and aspects of the NSIS II, as well as the responsibilities specified in the Action Plan, when developing policies, and planning and implementing national and EU co-funded programmes in the period between 2014 and 2020;

d) calls upon the relevant ministers to prepare an information sheet for the Minister of Human Capacities on the implementation of tasks set in the action plan starting from 2016;

e) calls the Minister of Human Capacities to operate a monitoring system in order to keep track of the implementation and impacts of the objectives of NSIS II and the responsibilities set in the action plan;

f) calls upon the Minister of Human Capacities to examine the options of taking into consideration the fullest possible access for those disadvantaged to quality human services in organizing them, in order to accomplish objectives laid down in the NSIS II;

g) calls upon the Minister of Human Capacities to revise, with the participation of the Minister for National Economy and the Minister of Interior, the possibilities of further harmonising social, labour market service and support as well as public employment systems to have a care system that encourages employment and contributes to preventing the transfer of poverty through generations.

2. This Decision shall enter into force on the day after it is published.

The National Social Inclusion Strategy and the governmental action plan on its implementation between 2015 and 2017

I. Tasks related to child welfare

1. The development of services aimed at harmonising raising children and employment should be supported, hence, in addition to increasing the flexibility of these types of care, developing pre-schools and other daycare benefits for children under age 3, extending capacities; primarily in locations deprived of services and lacking sufficient capacity.

Deadline: in line with the schedule of the programming period of the Regional Operational Programme (hereinafter: TOP) and the Competitive Central Hungary Operational Programme (hereinafter: VEKOP), on a continuous basis

2. Special attention should be paid to the earliest possible detection (right at the time of pregnancy) of differences in physical condition, mental state and skills, as well as to early intervention, skills management, early childhood (under 5) care, education and early development. In order to develop sectoral and inter-sectoral early childhood interventions, the regulation and restructuring of funding is in need of revision, as well as common professional protocols, a common child path, standardised screening, measuring and assessing system and training of professionals is needed together with raising awareness and strengthening their cooperation.

4. Coordinated initiatives should be launched and provide support to reinforcing families and communities, that might cover support for managing conflicts, parenting guidance, programmes to create a balance between family and work and model programmes aimed at the aforementioned objectives.

5. The number of children eligible for free or reduced-rate catering for children and beneficiaries of food aid programmes should be extended. Special attention should be paid to currently under-represented groups (in particular, children under age 3, who are not visiting an institution, and disadvantaged students in secondary schools), as well as to those eligible for discounts from catering or requiring a special diet due to their health condition. It should be examined how catering could be provided during school holidays and at weekends by extending child catering and reinforcing its legislative and funding guarantees.

6. The child protection warning system needs to be strengthened. The aim is to prevent the endangerment of children, eliminate already existing endangerment and promote the raising of children in families. It should be examined what targeted training and development programmes can be used to support services ensuring the earliest possible intervention and training to develop effective parenting, in particular programmes designed for abusive and neglecting parents, parents of children taken into care and parents disputing each other's right to child custody and visitation.

7. The aim is to eliminate all forms of child abuse and ensure the healthy mental development of endangered children removed from their families, and, in order to do so, it should be examined how the psychological support of children taking advantage of child welfare services or being raised in child protection special care can be provided.

8. In the context of foster parents' training, the registration of Roma candidates as foster parents, their participation in training and inclusion into foster parents' networks should be supported.

9. Mainstream child programmes in disadvantaged regions (beneficiary districts), as well as their professional and methodological support should be continued and extended in order to break the repeated cycle of poverty of families with children and improve their chances permanently and in the long term.

10. Complex child and youth services and programmes supported by professional and methodological background should be provided to settlements lacking services, where the rate of disadvantaged children is high.

11. In the context of early childhood opportunities, the reliable and transparent functioning of Sure Start Children's Homes should be ensured, and with the experience on success rates and if conditions for future operation are available, then these should be further developed and continuously supported in terms of methodology.

12. The way of providing service elements offered in the framework of child welfare service and family assistance should be examined, and with this knowledge, a more effective allocation of resources and regional differentiation should be promoted in relation to the two service system, taking into consideration the reduction of regional inequalities mentioned in Article 1 g) of the Decree. The availability of services should be improved.

13. The options for modifying the admission criteria to a child protection benefit under Act XXXI of 1997 on the Protection of Children and the Administration of Guardianship should be examined in order to reduce the number of children living in poor families and prevent the transfer of poverty to newer generations, as well as the notion and regulation of disadvantaged situations should be revised.

II Tasks related to education

1. The capacity of pre-school institutions to compensate disadvantages should be improved, and the infrastructural and personal conditions of pre-school care to disadvantaged children starting from age three should be established.

2. It should be examined which settlements have problems enrolling children in pre-school, and what is required to provide pre-school care to disadvantaged children. Any deficiencies experienced in this area should be explored and measures should be developed to manage them.

3. The capacity of the pre-school to compensate those disadvantaged should be reinforced by complex methodological development. Institutions should be prepared to provide quality pre-school education to disadvantaged children over age three.

4. Increasing the capacity of public education to create opportunities and the continued operation of skills development, integration preparation and pre-school development programme, as well as its methodological support and development should be ensured.

5. It should be examined if the teacher career recognizes the work done in education and talent management of disadvantaged children in an activity-oriented manner.

6. The capacity of the institutional system of public education to compensate for disadvantages should be reinforced by strengthening the practice of integrative education, and academically under-performing institutions should be developed by supporting desegregation processes.

7. Targeted measures should be taken to support the prevention of dropping out of school without a qualification, the academic success of student groups threatened by dropping out, in

particular vocational training. Special attention should be paid to the prevention of Roma girls leaving school without a qualification.

8. Access to complete pedagogical special services should be ensured, and access to quality and inclusive education of students with special educational needs, or struggling with difficulties of integration, learning or behaviour. Efforts should be made to improve the conditions of discharging duties and to ensure that complete and non-discriminatory care is being provided.

9. Programmes providing individual and complex support need to be continued, revised and improved (Road to Scholarship Programme, Arany János Talent Development Programme, Arany János Student Hostel Programme, Arany János Vocational School Programme, Szabóky Adolf Scholarship for Vocational Education, The Second Chance and remedial programmes) in order to facilitate the academic success of disadvantaged, cumulatively disadvantaged and Roma students.

10. Pedagogues, specialised trainers and assistant staff in public education should be provided with practice-based preparation in order to reinforce and disseminate the integrative educational practice.

The development of the system of services directly supporting teacher's work should be promoted, the role of the child protection indicator system should be strengthened at public education institutions and support should be provided to establishing inter-sectoral and inter-institutional models of cooperation, in order to reduce the number of students dropping out of school without a qualification.

12. Cooperation between teachers' training institutions and disadvantaged children's integrated institutions inside and outside the public education system (e.g. remedial programmes) should be promoted.

Special colleges for Roma should be developed and extended, the Student Mentor Programme should be extended, their range of services and activities should be widened, and the functioning of the Bursa Hungarica programme should be ensured, in order to support the graduation from higher education of disadvantaged and, in particular, Roma students coming from a disadvantaged background.

14. The scholarship and student grant system needs to be reformed in order to improve the chances of college students with socio-cultural disadvantages graduating from higher education.

15. Targeted programmes should be designed to support the physically active life-style and participation in recreational and student sport activities of disadvantaged and, in particular, Roma youth.

16. The participation of disadvantaged children/youth in talent management programmes should be ensured.

17. The targeted programmes of the cultural institutional system should also be employed to reduce inequalities of knowledge and skills as a result of various social disadvantages, and to compensate disadvantages. To this end, programmes should be launched to develop the number and variety of cultural services and activities, to design competence development model programmes, and the ways of cooperation between cultural and public education institutions should be established.

18. The IT system capable of tracking the entire life path (starting from their entry to public education to finishing higher education) of children (students, college students) in order to make services aimed at creating opportunities for disadvantaged children, students and college students more effective. The life path of disadvantaged students can only be tracked if the data stored in the public education information system (PIS) and the higher education information system (HIS) are interlinked and of high quality. When developing IT systems, general statistic aspects should be taken into account with the involvement of CSO.

19. The institutional circumstances influencing disadvantages at school should be examined, and targeted data collections and surveys should be considered to assess and monitor processes of segregation and desegregation measures.

III Tasks related to employment, training and economic integration

1. The already established network of social enterprises and associations should be extended by taking into consideration the boundaries between various EU development programmes, further supporting those existing, in order to make this form of employment an opportunity of advancement as an intermediary labour market for those leaving public employment, so that they can become association members or employees.

2. The employment opportunities of the disadvantaged should be extended by supporting forms of social economy that are financially sustainable for the long term.

4. Legislative amendments aimed at improving the employment of public employees on the primary labour market should be monitored, and new proposals should be developed

In line with the objectives of the Job Protection Action Plan, the costs of employing the target group should be cut in order to facilitate the employment of disadvantaged job-seekers on the labour market. Additional possibilities of reducing the employment costs of the target group should be considered.

7. In the framework of the Youth Guarantee, an active labour market programme should be operated to improve the labour market situation of job-seekers under the age of 25.

8. Targeted, complex and active labour market programmes should be conducted to promote the entry and re-entry of disadvantaged job-seekers to the labour market.

9. In order to improve the labour market situation of public employees with a low level of education, the training and training service programme for the attainment of vocational skills (including the recognition of the results of non-formal and informal learning, carrier orientation, mentoring, etc.) should be provided.

10. The harmonisation of duties in professional and private life should be promoted through programmes aimed at disseminating flexible forms of employment and flexible employment solutions.

11. Programmes aimed at developing the basic competences, providing compensatory education and training and offering social and other services should be launched for people with low levels of education and public employees.

12. Targeted adult training programmes aimed at developing the digital competences of disadvantaged adults, including, in particular, people with low levels of education and public employees, should be launched.

13. Training and employment programmes aimed at Roma women should be continued in order to ensure the integration of Roma women struggling with special difficulties. The options of vocational training should be examined in order to extend the opportunities of social groups with multiple disadvantages, in particular, Roma girls participating in school-based vocational training, to obtain a vocation and become employed.

14. The chances of employment of disadvantaged groups, e.g. Roma, should be improved with training and programmes, anticipating labour market processes, aimed at enabling employment and supporting an independent way of life.

The employment opportunities of disadvantaged groups, including, in particular, Roma, should be extended and the chances of becoming an entrepreneur should be improved by applying the tools of social economy, new and innovative solutions and through establishing business development centres. In so doing, efforts should be made to examine how business development centres could contribute to this, or, if necessary, how their activities should be improved.

IV. Tasks related to health care

1. The number of districts permanently lacking a local physician should be reduced by incentive and supporting programmes aimed at improving equal access to health care. General medical care should be strengthened, with particular attention to disadvantaged regions.

2. Healthy life-style and regular attendance at health screenings should be promoted by launching programmes targeted at disadvantaged regions, in particular, Roma women.

3. Health development programmes should be set up in public education institutions in order to establish comprehensive health development, with particular attention to health risks and issues affecting disadvantaged social groups.

4. Modern child health knowledge should be passed on by raising awareness and a shift in perceptions in a form accessible to disadvantaged parents and medical professionals working in disadvantaged settlements or regions to improve the health care provided to children.

5. Considering the various positive effects breast-feeding has on the physical and mental health of mother and child, participation in programmes promoting breast-feeding should be encouraged among medical professionals providing care in particularly disadvantaged regions in an effort to make breast-feeding more wide-spread.

6. Participation in programmes and taking advantage of interventions aimed at preventing addictions (in particular, alcohol consumption and drug use) should be improved among vulnerable young people. 7. Efforts should be made to support quitting smoking, with particular attention to disadvantaged regions.

V. Tasks related to the reduction of regional disadvantages and problems of housing

1. Complex programmes should be launched to socially and economically integrate disadvantaged regions. For this to happen, the framework, mechanisms of coordination and integration into local processes of harmonised interventions and services improving the chances of people living in underdeveloped districts should be established.

A complex programme should be launched to support human development projects aimed at the social and regional integration of groups living in slum-like environments, as well as the implementation of relevant investments into infrastructural development and housing. VI. Tasks related to inclusion, raising awareness and the fight against discrimination

1. The active participation of those disadvantaged, and, in particular, Roma, in society should be supported, and their civic associations and the involvement of Roma national municipal governments should be promoted. Special attention should be paid to supporting the involvement of Roma women in public and cultural life.

2. Boosting mechanisms (e.g. Roma mentoring network) should be employed to ensure that various programmes and development projects aimed at relieving disadvantages and creating opportunities actually reach Roma, and that Roma are given information and are motivated to participate in these programmes.

3. The positive role of the media in raising awareness should be strengthened by training Roma and those disadvantaged in media professions and employing them in the media or involving them in the production of media content.

Efforts should be made to ensure that the objectives and principles of social inclusion are integrated into the functioning of government offices and local governments, public services and, more importantly, human services in order to support the inclusion of those disadvantaged and Roma and improve their access to services.

7. The development of human and administrative services, as well as forms of institutional operation should be supported by programmes enabling the implementation of the principles and objectives of NSIS II.

8. Programmes aimed at promoting the responsible and consciously aware behaviour of youth should be continued and extended.

9. In the framework of tourism investments, Roma culture should be represented and recognized as a value and point of interest.

10. Community development programmes should be launched to reinforce local communities, methodological support should be provided to these programmes and cultural experts should be trained further and prepared using a practice-based method in order to implement integration programmes aimed at people and groups with different socio-cultural background. The role taken by the institutional system of public education in the area of social inclusion and community development should be strengthened through legal regulation.

11. The contents of textbooks and the curriculum related to poverty, groups with disadvantages, Roma/Gypsy nationality and the Roma/Gypsy holocaust should be revised with the involvement of relevant non-governmental organizations and researchers.

12. Research and programmes aimed at prevention and enlightenment would be needed to understand the processes of prostitution and human trafficking.

13. Effective prevention, raising awareness, enlightenment, and increasing awareness and prevention of becoming a victim would be needed in relation to human trafficking to serve the well-being of Roma women, migrant women and women under international protection with multiple disadvantages.

VII. Measures for coordinating the implementation of the strategy

1. Efforts should be made to maintain and develop the strategic monitoring system and the regular data updating of the indicator system. To this end, projects facilitating the application of the objectives of the National Reform Programme relating to the Europe 2020 strategy to alleviate poverty as well as the principles and objectives of NSIS II, and aimed at serving policy-making based on data entry for planning and monitoring, methodological development, evidence and assessment, should be implemented. The system of impact assessments relating to the interventions of the strategy, care and restructuring of services should be developed.

2. Relevant large sample statistical surveys examining the living conditions of people living in poverty and exclusion should be developed in order to examine the issue of transmitting poverty through generations and the potential interventions.

3. The National Segregation Database should be established, which should include the illustration of segregated territories on maps for individual settlements.

4. The poverty map of Hungary should be created by linking the census of 2011 and the Household Budget and Living Conditions Data Collection of the Central Statistical Office.

5. Methodological development projects launched to identify and assess good practices of programmes aimed at social inclusion and to set up publicity promoting the utilisation of experiences should be continued. The widely accessible database of good practices and proven actions should be created.

6. A standardized monitoring system ensuring the assessment of the impact public employment has on the labour market and the all-round technical information service ranging from the level of decision-making to the level of execution should be set up in order to inform both policy-makers and the public.

7. An economic forum promoting inclusion should be created to link the social responsibility of economic operators with the implementation of NSIS II.

8. In the framework of the Inter-Ministerial Committee for Social Inclusion and Roma Affairs, working groups supporting inter-sectoral coordination should be employed to reinforce the management of inclusion policy as a horizontal policy.

9. An assistance system supporting local governments of settlements in revising and implementing local equal opportunities programmes. Local equal opportunities programmes should be subjected to assessment.

10. The regulatory framework of local equal opportunities programmes and the system of district-level coordination facilitating the harmonisation and implementation of local equal opportunities plans should be further developed on the basis of the conclusions drawn from the assessment of effective local equal opportunities programmes.

11. Cooperation and exchange of experience between member states implementing the European Framework Strategy for Roma as well as between affected countries (the V4 states in particular) should be supported through programmes in order to promote the social inclusion of Roma living in the Carpathian basin.

12. The statistical tools for collecting ethnic and minority data should be developed in order to improve the effectiveness of interventions and development projects aimed at social inclusion as well as to better target these measures.
